ANNUAL SANTA RITA STAR-SPANGLED CELEBRATION

The Big Lake Chamber of Commerce will host the **Santa Rita Star-Spangled Celebration** at Reagan County North Park on **Saturday, July 4, 2026**. The event will include a car Show, four live bands including Texas Country headliner **Tyce Delk, Carson Jeffery, Keith Nieto and Gannon Fremen & CCREV the Bad Boyz** **Fireworks Show**.

We invite all vendors to participate fun family event. Vendors must complete the registration form and follow all **Texas Tax ID requirements (all vendors)** and **State Health Department regulations (food vendors)**. These documents must be submitted to the Chamber with your application. **If your application is incomplete or missing required documentation, a booth space will not be assigned until all requirements are met.**

Please note: Under the **Texas Cottage Food Law**, certain food vendors may not be required to obtain a temporary food permit. However, all food vendors participating in this event are required to provide a valid Food Handler Certification and must comply with all applicable state and local regulations.

Booth spaces are approximately **12' x 15'**. The cost is **\$45 per booth without electricity** and **\$50 per booth with electricity (food vendors only)**. Booth spaces for food vendors will be located behind the Community Center where electrical hookups are available. You can send a check, cashier's check, cash. **All payments are non-refundable.** (Cannot Sell ALCOHOL)

On **Friday, July 3rd and Saturday, July 4th**, please check in at the **Chamber tent** to receive your designated booth space. We are allowing trailers and booth to set-up on Friday from 4pm – 7pm and Saturday from 7am - 11pm.

All booths must be fully set up, and all vehicles must be moved to the designated parking area by 11:00 AM on Saturday. **Any vehicle remaining in the vendor area after this time will be towed at the owner's expense.**

We are asking vendors not to close their booth or begin breakdown **Before 5:00 PM**. Vendors are not allowed to leave the premises during the event to restock or retrieve additional supplies. Vendors are responsible for bringing an adequate amount of product. Please plan accordingly, as this event has had attendance exceeding 10,000 people in previous years.

Once the event begins, vendors will not be allowed to move vehicles in or out of the vendor area unless there is a MEDICAL EMERGENCY. Vendors who do not plan to stay for the evening performances may exit at 6:00 PM via the 4-H barns.

*Lighting will be available in the vendor area. Vendors must provide their own tables, extension cords, trash containers, and electrical adapters RV converter ***Registration Deadline: Friday, June 19, 2026.**
